ADMINISTRATIVE ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE CAMBRIDGE CONFERENCE, 1978

1. DATE: from 4 p.m. on WEDNESDAY, 29th March
to 2 p.m. on SATURDAY, 1st April

4. ACCESS : St. Catharine's College is centrally situated on Trumpington Street, which is a continuation of King's Parade. It lies immediately adjacent to King's College, on the south (London) side.

IMPORTANT NOTE Cambridge streets are narrow and a very comprehensive one-way system operates. It is possible to stop briefly in order to set down passengers in Queen's Lane (between Queen's College and the rear of St. Catharine's). It is NOT POSSIBLE to stop in Silver Street at the side of the College, and it is PROHIBITED for private cars to turn left of Silver Street and go on north past the front of the College.

By car from the North: A1 to Huntingdon, then A604 via Huntingdon to Cambridge. In the town, follow signs for Colchester (right turn at top of Castle Hill), along Queens Road ('the Backs') to traffic-lights turn left into Silver Street, over river and take small first turning to left (Queens Lane) : see above.

By car from North-west, West, Wales, etc.: M1 to Newport Pagnell, then A 45 via Bedford to Cambridge; when in the town, follow signs for Colchester and proceed as above from the North.

By car from London and South: along A10. This enters the city along Trumpington Street in which the College stands (BUT see above). Those coming from the South West are recommended to come via Windsor-Slough-Watford (bypass)- A1 to Baldock- A505 to Royston, then A10 as above.

By train: Cambridge station is about 1½ miles from the city centre and from College. Take a bus to the centre or a taxi to College.

5. PARKING: It is regretted that there is STRICTLY NO PARKING in the College. There are multi-storey parks at Lion Yard (Downing Street-Corn Exchange) and Jesus Lane, etc., clearly sign-posted. Free parking is available along roads in West Cambridge, such as Sidgwick Avenue and West Road which are right turns off Queen's Road ('the Backs'); also along Queen's Road itself.

The enclosed map shows details of both access and parking. St. Catharine's College is on squares E 3 and 4; the A604 enters in D6; the A45 enters in D5; the A10 enters in F1; the multi-storey parks are in E4 and E5.

6. ACCOMMODATION: Rooms will be available from 4 p.m. on WEDNESDAY 29th March. Towel and soap are provided. Rooms will be available for the Music Group from 4 p.m. on Tuesday 28th March if due notice is given in each case.
7. BARS: There will be two bars in operation at lunchtimes and in the evenings.
8. PLACES OF INTEREST: No excursion is being arranged, but pamphlets will be available about places of interest in the City and University; also details of trips to Ely, Audley End, Bury St. Edmunds, etc.
9. UNIVERSITY LIBRARY: There will be a visit to an exhibition at the University Library on the afternoon of Friday, 31st March.
10. BUFFET SUPPER: This will be available from 7.30 to 9.00 p.m. on the evening of arrival, Wednesday 29th March.
