Thanks for your letter. Yes, I think we can go ahead for a scholarship for next year. I have received (including your most generous offer) nearly £35 and more should come in; we can always borrow something from the General Fund. Some late subs. from last year have eliminated the small deficit I had to report in the Treasurer's Report. The only thing is that we shall probably find it difficult to whack out £50 a year, which with the other £10.10.0 commitment of the Jones prize, involves a good £1 a head of all 60-odd members. This we shall have to discuss in due course.
