Thanks very
much for your letter & for giving
me the suggested date for the
Conference and the J.F.

I find now that the Summer Term
at Cambridge will start next year
on April 19th. May 13th is very close
to the exams & that is why discussing
dates with Prof. Trend, we thought it
would be advisable to have the

Jobs on the 6th, as it may make things easier for the students wishing to attend. But of course we have also to take into account the calendar of other Universities. Perhaps it will be necessary to discuss this with Prof. Pierce & know how he feels about it.

The suggestion is to hold the Jobs at the hall of Christ's College early in the afternoon. But, of course, we cannot say yet anything about this until the College authorities have taken a decision. The Master of Christ's has just been appointed Vice-Chancellor.

I am waiting to get the rules for the J.F., forms etc from the

Patronat dels J.F., now resident at Mexico.

A "Comissió Organitzadora" should then be formed in this country for arrangements, publicity & collecting funds

Finally, "Els VII Mantenedors" should be elected to act as the jury to award the prizes. Since Josep Carner is the most outstanding Catalan poet abroad he has been suggested as the President. He is at Brussels & knows English & English literature very well.

A local Committee should also be formed at Cambridge to help in preparing the Conference & the jocs, finding accommodation etc

But it will be no use to set it up
just now when everyone is going
away.

Perhaps it could be useful if
the committee of the A.C.S could
meet before we all disperse. I shall
be going to France early in July.
