

THE ANGLO-CATALAN SCHOLARSHIP.

Established in 19 by the Anglo-Catalan Society.

The conditions of award are as follows:-

1. The scholarship shall be called the Anglo-Catalan Scholarship. Society?
2. The object of the scholarship is to further cultural relations between England and Catalonia.
3. The scholarship, normally of the value of £50, shall be awarded annually by the Anglo-Catalan Society. No award will be made if no candidates of sufficient merit present themselves.
4. The money shall be spent in pursuing an academic course of study at any British University. A list of such courses will be found in the publications of the British Council. Some of these?
5. It shall be open to all Catalans between the ages of 18 and 30 who have a working knowledge of spoken and written English. No candidate may be awarded the scholarship on more than one occasion.
6. Applications, in duplicate, should be forwarded direct to the President, Anglo-Catalan Society, Department of Spanish, Nottingham University, University Park, Nottingham, England, enclosing details of curriculum vitae and any other relevant information. Recommendations from two persons of academic standing should be included. Applications must reach the President on or before 31st January of the year in which the award is to be made.
7. The judges will be the Committee of the Anglo-Catalan Society.
8. After completion of the course, a report shall be sent by the successful candidate to the President.

(the point being that it need not necessarily be only those courses advertised by the B.C.)
