As a Trustee for certain matters concerning Mr. Perera and his wife Pilar, I opened your recent letter sent to 201 Woodford Avenue.

Unfortunately I have to advise you that Ramon Perera passed away on the 24th November 1988 and his wife Pilar Perera passed away the next day, the 25th November, and I am sorry to be the one to pass on such sad news.

In doing so, I am wondering whether the Society could assist me with a small problem concerning many books left by both deceased, printed in Spanish/Catalan, which they always wanted to pass on to anybody who might be interested in them as against destruction. I might say I have already sent 150 kilos of books to a lady in Barcelona at a cost of £236, but there remains probably another 150 kilos.

I would most prefer to execute the wishes of both deceased and pass the books on, as a gift to some party or Institution without obligation, rather than have them recycled as paper.

In writing to you possibly you could offer a suggestion, or arrange for a Catalan lady or gentleman who lives near Woodford Avenue to call and inspect the books and assess the possibility of having them collected and distributed for future use by your Society members, or sold for the Society's benefit.
