As announced, the XXVI Annual Conference of the Anglo-Catalan Society will be held in Fitzwilliam College, Cambridge, from the evening of Friday, September 26th, to lunch-time on Sunday, September 28th.

A reservation form, details of administrative arrangements and provisional programme are enclosed, together with material for the XXVI AGM.

Please note that all rooms in Fitzwilliam are single and that men and women will be accommodated on different landings.

Owing to difficulties in contacting speakers over the holiday period and to other unavoidable administrative problems, it has not been possible to finalise exact details of the Conference proceedings. However, it is not expected that there will be any major departures from the provisional programme enclosed, and a final programme will be made available to members on arrival. Abstracts of papers will also be distributed at the Conference itself. Any member unable to attend who wishes to receive copies of abstracts is asked to request them from me (with s.a.e.) as soon as possible after the meeting.

Publication of No. 1 of the Anglo-Catalan Society Occasional Publications (Salvador Giner, The Social Structure of Catalonia), announced for September in the First Circular, will now unfortunately be delayed until late October. Full details and pre-publication subscription forms will be available at the Conference or, for those not attending, on request by post from me. Members are also reminded that the Editorial Committee will welcome suggestions for future titles in the series.

A 1980-81 subscription form is enclosed for the use of members not attending the Cambridge meeting. Those attending are requested by the Treasurer to make all payments of fees and subscriptions direct to him at the Conference itself.
