
Dear Dr. Walker:

PROJECT: "CATALONIA: LAND, PEOPLE, CULTURE"

This project consisting of an undetermined series of books written in English envisions to spread facts on Catalonia throughout the world and towards the future. It will be like a repository of archival type maintained by libraries and persons throughout the world interested in the history, music, science, religion, grammar, politics, etc. of Catalonia.

We have in mind a very ambitious project to be published in several volumes which may take many years and require many scholarly authors. It will be written as chapters by different experts willing to collaborate.

Suggested topics for chapters may be for instance: Geography, Demography, Catalan Institutions, Archaeology, Political History, Military History, Economic Development, Ethical Heritage, Christianity, Folks and Handicraft, Literature, Music, Architecture, Sculpture, Painting, Maritime History, Catalan Language, Development of Book Printing, Catalan Influences in Europe, Catalan Influences in Hispano-America, Catalan Influences in North America, Catalan Emigration in 1939, Influence of Other Literatures on Catalan, Catalan Influences on Other Literatures; Medicine; Science; Philosophy, etc., etc.

These titles do not pretend to be exhaustive, but to give simply an idea of the possible chapters.

That this is no illusory project can be asserted by the fact that a similar work is being published about CROATIA, edited by F. H. Eterovich and C. Spalatin, University of Toronto Press, Vol. I 1964, Vol. II 1970, that you may wish to consult.
