Visitors living in Canterbury Hall during the vacation are asked to co-operate in the following arrangements, which are designed to safeguard the comfort and convenience of all residents.

GLOSING HOURS

The <u>Street Door</u> is locked at 11.30 p.m. Keys are available, and may be collected from the Porter's Lodge.

All public rooms are closed at 11.30 p.m.

Lifts may not be used after 12 midnight.

Residents are asked not to take baths, use the ironing rooms, or play radios after 11 p.m., in order to ensure quietness throughout the Hall. All parties in residents' rooms must end by 11 p.m. and music should not be played in the Concert Hall after that time.

GUESTS

Guests must be met in the entrance hall and sign the Guest Book at the Porter's Lodge.

Guests must leave the building by 11 p.m.

Guests may be invited to meals, which must be ordered and paid for at breakfast. A ticket must be purchased from the waitress, and handed back to the waitress when the meal is served. The charges are:

ROOMS

It would be appreciated if residents would please make their own beds and leave their rooms tidy.

Residents must not stick pictures, etc., on walls or doors. The occupier of the room will be charged for any damage.

ROOM KEYS
