Dear Paul,

Many thanks for your letter, and you have all my sympathy over accommodation in Cambridge & the elusiveness of Batista !

Yes, I'd like to read my paper. There are two possibilities. I've got a very nice series of coloured slides of the Karlsruhe miniatures, which I think would go down rather well, but that would mean (a) the use of a projector [if need be, Gili would probably oblige - he helped me with this when I gave a talk on them here not long ago] ; and (b) a longer session - perhaps an evening one like Dr. Weaver's illustrated talk last year ? In that case : title = "The Karlsruhe miniatures & the structure of the Lullian universe". If that's no good, then a paper called "The terminological structure of the Lullian world-picture" for an ordinary session. *Let me know which, & then I'll set about the abstract.*

Mind you, the miniatures are rather fun, & might add a touch of variety !
