

Dear Professor,

I have received today the letter of the 20th January signed by yourself, Professors Pierce, Tate and Ribbons, as well as by Mrs. Helen Grant of the University of Cambridge, in which you raise the matter of the re-opening of the library of the "Instituto de Estudios Catalanes", in Barcelona, which you say was closed owing to the suspension of the organization "Omnium Cultural" housed in the same building.
