
Anglo-Catalan Society Meeting 19-20 November, 1982

I know you have already discussed with Dr Walker several matters in connection with holding our annual meeting at the Instituto de España again this year. The Society is very grateful for your generous offer of hospitality. I am writing now to confirm the dates: from the evening of Friday 19 November to the evening of Saturday 20 November.
